The following Career Clusters are important in all Programs of Study and courses will be available as part of completion status after the student concentrates in another Program of Study.

- Concentrator: A student who completes two courses in a program of study.
- Completer: A student who completes three courses (two in a program of study and one in the program of study or in a cross-cutting program).

The Programs of Study are available as "Stand-Alone" Programs also.

Example: A student can concentrate in Fashion Merchandising and then take courses in Web Design in order to complete.

(Note: The Cross-Cutting Sector courses must be taught by a properly endorsed teacher.)
